

Great Plains Film Festival Screenwriting Contest Results

10 scripts were honored: 3 Honorable Mention, 7 Finalists, and 1 Winner.

The judges did not know who wrote the scripts, nor the authors' city of origin.

Half of the top ten scripts authors reside currently in Nebraska, one in Pennsylvania, and four are from California.
